I have been advised by Director Occupational Health & Safety Unit as follows:

- 1. The Electricity and the Workplace Health & Safety Acts require all electrical work to be done by an 'electrical worker'. The definition of electrical worker includes electrical tradespersons (i.e. electricians), electrical engineers and those who are holders of restricted certificates.
- 2. Staff without one of the above qualifications are not permitted to carry out any electrical work in Queensland.
- 3. No member of Prentice Centre staff is to work on electrical appliances unless correctly qualified. Please note that removing the covers from an electrical appliance (e.g. personal computers, audio visual equipment) such as to make components accessible constitutes electrical work.
