MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

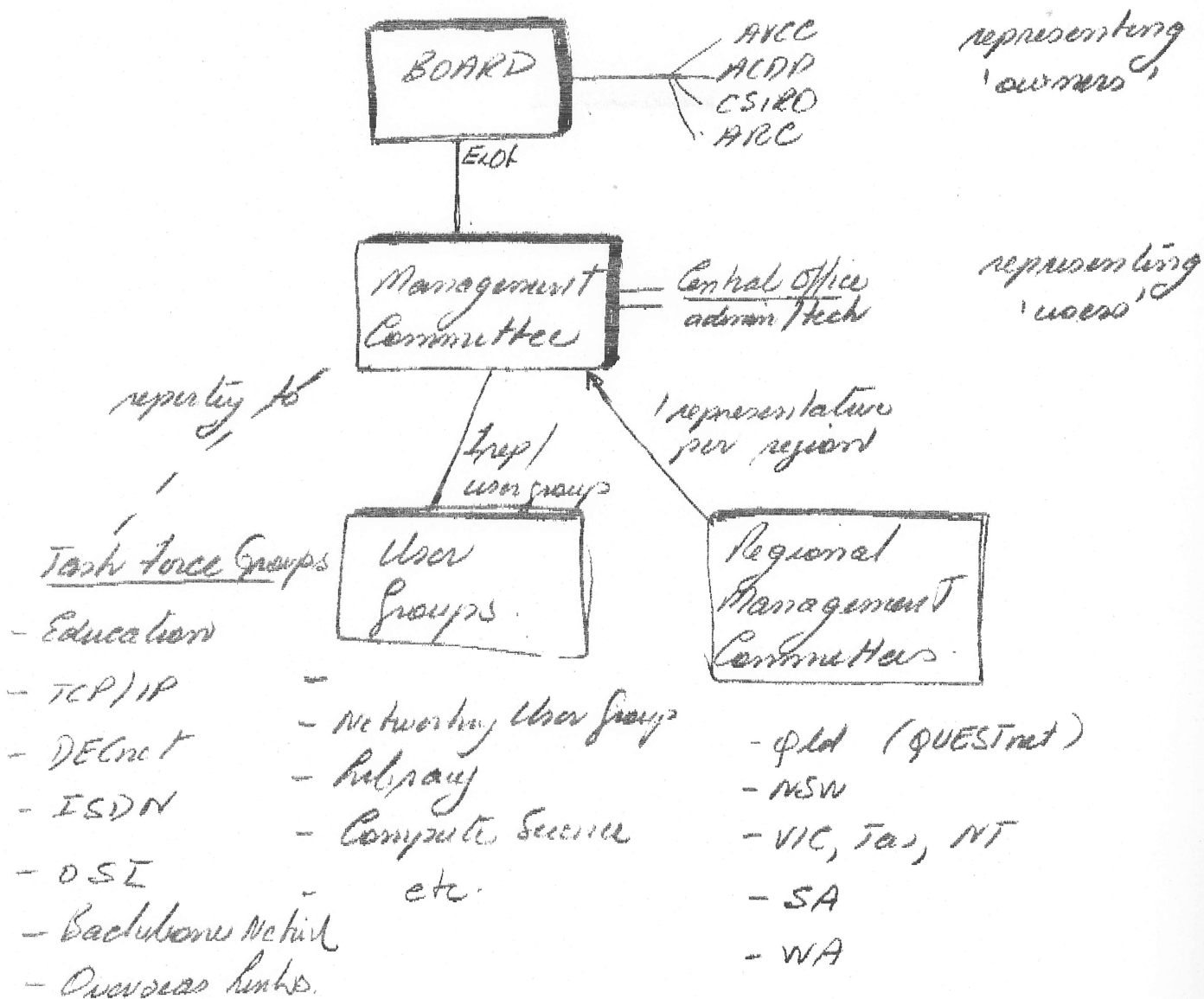
represents the users.
