At first read I like your proposal, which appears to be similar to but in some ways more developed than proposals I made earlier.

However, I don't think we are going to get any such major change at this stage. I think the discussions on January 24 (which I shall miss, being on holiday) will focus on wording changes within the spirit of the "agreement" reached at the Steering Committee's last meeting. What that "agreement" is, is anyone's guess; well, I suppose it's John Mullarvey's interpretation that counts, as he's writing the minutes!

I think the position we got to was that it would be initially strongly centralised, but would move to a more regional structure as strong regional groups developed. It was not specified where and how the boundaries would be drawn.

I think the best bet is to send your rep to the 24th January meeting with specific amendments to the Management Structure draft. Coulter and Carss should have a copy, and one went to your VC recently, too. The game now is to win concessions which will allow movement towards a regional structure ASAP.
