### Why Do We Need SERT?

- ✳ Success of CERT Coordination Centre in USA
- ✳ AARNet is large (>80,000 hosts)
- ✳ Need security coordination locally
- ✳ Reduce costs to AARNet members
- ✳ Aid to small sites
- ✳ Establish and maintain trusted relationships

## What is SERT?

- ✳ Security Emergency Response Team
- ✳ Trusted Centre of Security Expertise
- ✳ Analysis of Security Incidents
- ✳ Response to Security Incidents
  - help sites
  - recommend a defence
- ✳ Dissemination of Security Information
- ✳ Education and Security Tools

## SERT

### What Will SERT Do For Me?

- \* Provide help on computer security and liaison
- \* Recommend action for known vulnerabilities
- \* Central source of security information
- \* Raise security awareness
- \* Preserve confidentiality and privacy
- \* Comply with relevant Laws

## What Won't SERT Do For Me?

- \* Can't fix your security problems
  - will provide assistance
  - will provide pointers
- \* Will not take disciplinary action on your behalf

### How Was SERT Formed?

- \* Cooperative venture - UQ, QUT, GU
- \* Funding locally first half 1993
- \* Funding support from other universities second half 1993
- \* Function recognised by AVCC - request for tender

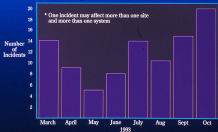

## SERT

### What Has SERT Done So Far?

- \* Operational since 8 March 1993
- \* Handled > 100 incidents
- \* Large incident involving a coordinated tftp attack
- \* Emergency after hours site notification
  - wuarchive
  - gopher
  - sendmail

## What Has SERT Done So Far?

- \* Issued ten advisories
- \* Megapatch
- \* Technical papers on security issues
- \* Local ftp archive site
- \* Assistance to the AFP
