

Why Do We Need SERT?

- Success of CERT Coordination Centre in USA
 - AARNet is large (>80,000 hosts)
 - Need security coordination locally
 Reduce costs to AARNet members.
 - * Aid to small sites
 - Aid to small sites
 Establish and maintain trusted relationships



What is SERT?

- Security Emergency Response Team
 - Trusted Centre of Security Expertise
 - Analysis of Security Incidents
 - Response to Security Incidents
 - help sites - recommend a defence
 - Dissemenation of Security Information
 - Education and Security Tools



What Will SERT Do For Me?

- Provide help on computer security and liaison
 Recommend action for known vulnerabilities
 - Recommend action for known vumeraounue
 Central source of security information
 - Raise security awareness
 Preserve confidentiality and privacy
