PCC-Microsoft price agreement cuts software costs by up to 80%

The signing of an 'Education Consortium Agreement' between the Prentice Computer Centre and Microsoft will allow University users to obtain large discounts on Microsoft products. Students, staff and University departments can now purchase fully featured 'Academic Editions' of certain popular Microsoft software for as little as one fifth of the Recommended Retail Price. Most Microsoft products not covered by the 'Academic Editions' still attract discounts of around 40%.

The agreement also covers classroom and office packages (Edpacks and Class-in-a-Box). Edpacks feature 10 licences and one set of documentation. They are ideal for classrooms and self-contained offices where several machines are using the software but one manual can serve the needs of all users. The Microsoft Word 5.0 Edpack costs \$725.00, or \$72.50 per user. Class-in-a-Box are sets of teaching materials for certain Microsoft products.

Also covered are 'EdNet' packs, which are Local Area Network versions of the more popular packages. They consist of file-server software, a ten-user licence and one set of documentation. Prices for EdNet packs are similar to those for Edpack.

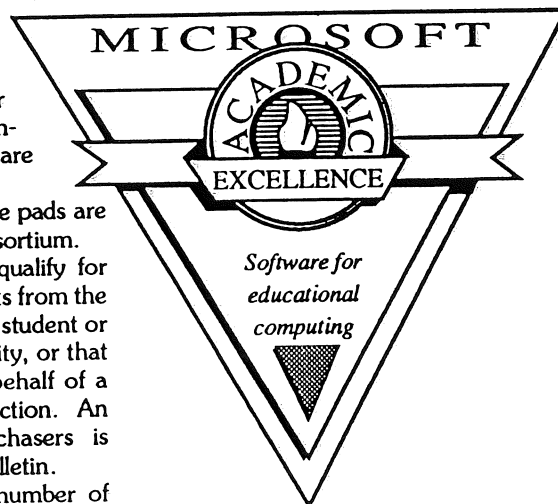
Microsoft Mouse and mouse pads are also available through the Consortium.

The only requirement to qualify for Educational Consortium benefits from the PCC is to prove that you are a student or member of staff at the University, or that you are placing an order on behalf of a University department or section. An order form for private purchasers is provided at the back of this Bulletin.

Microsoft has selected a number of software products for special discounts and packaged them as 'Academic Editions'. Packaged with fewer 'frills' and a soft cover manual, 'Academic Editions' are otherwise identical to the commercial version, at a drastically reduced price (see

table on right). Mac and MSDOS Word, Works, and Excel are among the titles offered in this format. The buyer is entitled to upgrades on the same terms as the commercial user.

University users are required to place their orders through the Prentice Computer Centre. Departmental purchases require an Inter-departmental Requisition or a PCC Equipment and Materials Order. Staff and students may pay the PCC cashier at the Help Desk as they hand in
