The LP10F and LP10H are drum-type line printers designed with emphasis on output quality and operating reliability.

The two-speed capability of the 64-character LP10F and the 96-character LP10H increases the printing quality for both low-speed operation and multi-part forms handling. The LP10F operates at 1250 or 925 lines/minute; the LP10H at 925 or 675 lines/minute.

The Optical Vertical-Format Unit uses 12-channel tape.

The Quick-Change Drum allows a change of character set in just five minutes.

The operator-selectable Ribbon Counter controls the number of ribbon reversals permitted before simultaneous alarm light and paper-fault indications signal the need for a new ribbon.

The Penetration Control allows the operator to adjust the degree of penetration to accommodate different types of forms and paper.

The Forms Control allows operator adjustment for various paper sizes and form thicknesses.

The Test Panel allows off-line adjustments and repairs in a self-test mode.
